Hiking Rules:

- Everyone who is hiking today must sign the club register and must have completed and signed a waiver.
- Photos and GPS tracking are allowed on SW hikes; however, publishing photos or specific maps or coordinates, identifying sensitive areas, such as ruin sites and rock art, is strictly prohibited. This restriction includes print media and internet websites.
- SW hikers will practice a Leave-No-Trace policy, avoid sensitive soil, and respect wildlife.
- Each hiker must have sufficient water (at least 2 quarts and up to a gallon on hot, dry days).
- Hikers need to bring lunch and a snack for all hikes (snack only for Rustler and Drover hikes).
- Everyone must wear lug-soled hiking boots.
- Stay between the Leader and the Tailgater at all times.
- Carrying a cell phone is encouraged, but it must be turned off except in an emergency and then used only with the Leader's consent.
- Notify the Leader immediately of illness or injury.
- All hikers are expected to complete hikes. In the case of illness or injury, a hiker may leave the hike with the consent of the Leader if accompanied by two people, at least one of whom knows the trail.
